Fishing Lodge Going Green



Wind energy and solar power are in the works as one of the province's fishing lodges embarks on an environmental initiative. Flowers River Lodge in Labrador, the most northerly hook and release fishing lodge in the province, has announced that it is going totally green this June. Owner-operator, Jim Burton, a well known St. John's realtor, says state of the art solar power equipment, combined with a 90 foot windmill, will be installed in the next few months that will generate all its electricity needs. He says their dependable Lister 16kv diesel generator will become a standby power source. Burton says this is a very significant development for Flowers River Lodge and they are proud to work with the provincial government's Green Fund in

making this project become a reality. Flowers River is a very popular location for fishing enthusiasts from this province, across Canada and parts of the United States.
